**Public Hearing and Workshop on Proposed Design Guidelines**  
*Public Information Meeting Scheduled for June 3*

The City of San Fernando Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing and community workshop on proposed architectural design guidelines for new building construction in San Fernando. The meeting is scheduled for June 3, 7:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers, 117 Macneil Street.

Design consultant Roger Cantrell and City staff will discuss how the draft guidelines would pertain to new construction and general improvements of properties throughout the community. Draft design guidelines for single-family residential, multi-family residential and commercial/institutional development have been prepared, in English and Spanish. They also include advice on landscaping treatments and plants that do well in San Fernando.

If approved, these design guidelines would be used by City staff in working with property owners and design professionals in preparing plans for new construction requiring City approval and building permits. The workshop will offer information on how use of the design guidelines will encourage new construction that enhances and preserves the community's neighborhoods while maintaining its small-town feel.
