California Friendly Gardening Workshop June 21
Transform Your Garden into a Water-Conserving, Money-Saving Oasis

Home gardeners who are ready to cut their water bills in half can sign up to attend the free California Friendly Gardening Workshop on Saturday, June 21. The event takes place from 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. in the Japanese Teahouse at Heritage Park, 2025 Fourth Street.

Hosted by the City of San Fernando and offered by the Metropolitan Water District, participants will learn how to make their gardens California friendly. Among the topics to be discussed: landscape design basics, plant selection criteria, soils and fertilizer, and irrigation. Aside from being low maintenance, California friendly gardens also reduce water use, urban runoff and green waste to local landfills.

The workshop will be offered in English and Spanish formats.
