*Residents Can Dispose Waste Free of Charge*

In partnership with Crown Disposal and Denny's Restaurant, the City of San Fernando will host a Neighborhood Clean-Up Day on June 7 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. The free event will allow residents to dispose non-hazardous items like furniture, trash and debris. Items must be brought to the Civic Center parking lot located at Maclay Avenue and First Street.

Proof of residency is required. Residents will need to present a current driver's license or water bill upon arrival.
