Kewen Street Shootings *City Offers \$10,000 Reward*

The San Fernando City Council is offering a \$10,000 reward for information leading to the arrest of the person responsible for shooting and injuring two males on the 1100 block of Kewen Street. The first and only shooting of the year, the incident took place on July 2, 2007 at 9:49 p.m.

After detectives exhausted leads in the case, the City Council approved a motion on Monday night to offer the reward. According to Police Chief Robert Ordelleide, "We are determined to find whoever is responsible for the shooting. With this large reward, we are confident that this will result in some new and solid leads."

The two victims, both male and ages 33 and 46, were independently returning from a nearby store when the suspect opened fire from the side of a dumpster. One victim sustained two gunshot wounds and the other, a single gunshot wound. The victims did not have gang ties nor were they involved in domestic or neighborhood disputes.

Detectives describe the suspect as a 5'8", 190 lb. Hispanic male in his mid-20s with a shaved head. He was a passenger in a white late model Lexus or Chevrolet Impala. The vehicle was last seen heading north on San Fernando Mission Boulevard.
