Neighborhood Clean-Up Day January 26
Residents can dispose waste FREE of charge

In partnership with Crown Disposal, the City of San Fernando will host a Neighborhood Clean-Up Day on January 26 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. The free event will allow residents to dispose non-hazardous items like furniture, trash and debris. Items must be brought to the Civic Center parking lot located at Maclay Avenue and First Street.

Proof of residency is required. Residents will need to present a current driver's license or water bill upon arrival.

The City will also provide disposal pick-up for seniors and the disabled. Appointments can be made by calling the City's Community Development Department at (818) 898-1227.

Residents are reminded that they can dispose hazardous waste free of charge by visiting the East San Fernando Valley S.A.F.E. Collection Center located at 11025 Randall Street, Sun Valley.
