Dog Vaccination, Licensing and Microchipping Clinic *Low-Cost Clinic Set for June 13*

Bring your dog to City Hall for low-cost vaccinations, licensing and microchipping. The City of San Fernando's annual pet clinic will be held June 13 from 8:30 to 10 a.m. at 117 Macneil St.

Vaccinations. Rabies vaccinations will be available for \$6, and dogs over four months of age are required by law to have the vaccination every year. The clinic will also offer a 6-in-1 vaccination for dogs over eight weeks of age. The \$14 vaccination is recommended annually and covers distemper, hepatitis, leptospirosis, parainfluenza, parvovirus and bordetella.

Licensing. Licensing services will be provided by the County of Los Angeles. To renew or receive a dog license, a spay or neuter certificate and a copy of the rabies vaccination is required. Licensing fees are \$20 per dog; seniors can receive a discounted fee of \$7.50.

Licenses can also be obtained for unaltered dogs. The cost is \$60 per dog and is conditioned upon the completion of an Exemption Application. An application form can be obtained at the clinic.

Dog licenses are required by law. Most licenses expire annually by June 30 and if not renewed by this date, a penalty fee may occur.

Microchipping. Free microchip implantations will also be available. Microchips positively identify a lost pet and help reunite them to their owner.

Cash and check payments will be accepted. All dogs must be on a leash.
