Smoke Advisory in Effect, Recreational Facilities Closed *Poor Air Quality Continues with Local Wildfires*

A smoke advisory for the city of San Fernando remains in effect from local wildfires. Air quality is poor with high levels of smoke, ash and other particulates. Residents are urged to avoid vigorous outdoor activities and children, the elderly, and those with respiratory or heart disease should remain indoors.

The following city facilities will be closed with cancelled programming until further notice:

Las Palmas Park, 505 S. Huntington St.

- Gymnasium is closed; programming cancelled.
- All outdoor sporting activities are cancelled; fields are closed and lights are off.

Pioneer Park, 828 N. Harding Ave.

- All outdoor sporting activities are cancelled; fields are closed and lights are off.

Recreation Park, 208 Park Ave.

- Gymnasium is closed; programming cancelled.
- All outdoor sporting activities are cancelled; fields are closed and lights are off.

San Fernando Regional Pool Facility, 208 Park Ave.

- Facility is closed; programming cancelled.

Senior programming held in the community rooms at Recreation and Las Palmas parks will continue as scheduled.
