SAN FERNANDO PUBLIC WORKS ANNOUNCES "PROJECT POTHOLE"

Focus on expedited street repairs

Recent heavy rains have taken a toll on City streets, with cracks and potholes appearing citywide. In response Public Works announces "Project Pothole".

Project Pothole is a proactive approach to pothole repair, whereby all city employees, including police officers on patrol, work as a team with the public to be observant for potholes, and to report them promptly to the Public Works Dispatch email address pwdispatch@sfcity.org

The goal of Project Pothole is to perform a city wide inspection for potholes, complete all repairs as needed, and also complete work on a backlog of street repair work orders.

As a result of these efforts, during the month of January, a total of 317 potholes were filled and 102 street repair work orders were completed.
