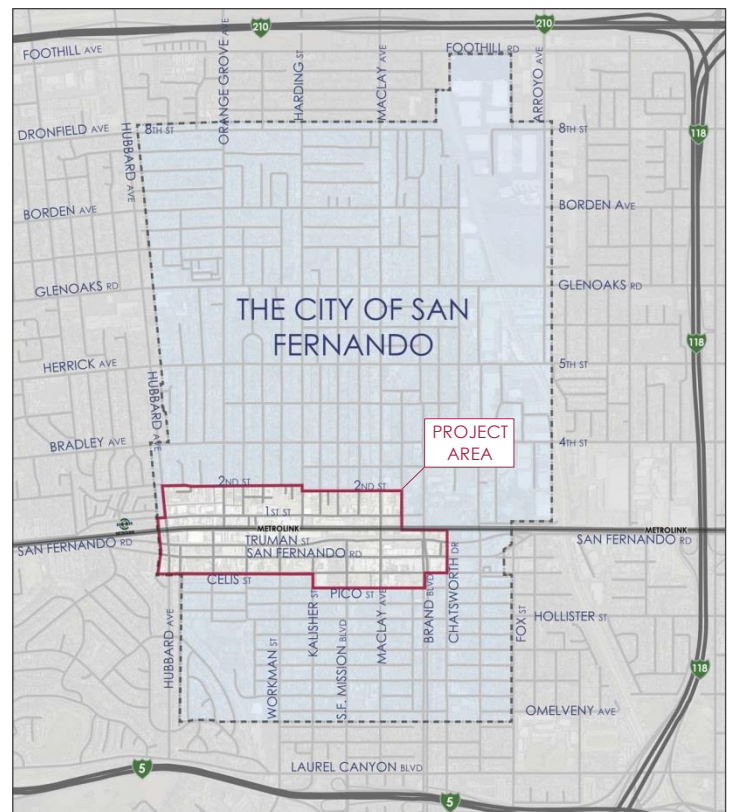

The City of San Fernando is preparing a Zoning Code update for the area between the Sylmar/San Fernando Metrolink station and the San Fernando Mall. With a grant from the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro), the City has retained a team of consultants led by Sargent Town Planning to:

- Update City Zoning Codes and the Corridors Specific Plan to make the area more walkable, allow new commercial uses and introduce multi-family housing in areas where it is not currently allowed.
- Generate a program level Environmental Impact Report (EIR) to determine any potential environmental effects of the new zoning.
- Amend the General Plan to be consistent with the new zoning.
