SAN FERNANDO LAUNCHES FIVE ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS

WHO/WHAT: San Fernando, CA – On Monday, June 25, 2018, the City of San Fernando will host an official ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the successful launch of five electric vehicle charging stations throughout the city. This investment brings an alternative sustainable fuel option to the San Fernando community at five convenient locations, each equipped with dual charging stations.

About the Electric Vehicle Charging Station Program

Transportation is one of the largest and fastest growing contributors to greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. Installing EV charging stations is a proactive step towards reducing the City's carbon footprint.

In 2017, the City of San Fernando was awarded a \$100,000 grant by the Mobile Source Air Pollution Review Committee (MSRC) via the Clean Transportation Funding Grant Program to install publicly accessible Electric Vehicle charging stations. The grant required matching funds which the City of San Fernando provided via the parking and maintenance operations special fund. Energy costs related to the use of the EV stations will be funded through user fees associated with vehicle charging.
