CITY OF SAN FERNANDO VICE MAYOR ANTONIO LOPEZ AND COUNCILMEMBER ROBERT GONZALES JOINED NALEO EDUCATIONAL FUND AND UCLA FOR FIRST NATIONAL EDUCATION LEADERSHIP AND PUBLIC POLICY ACADEMY

Three-day intensive convening allowed Lopez and Gonzales and 60 Latino elected officials to learn about effective public policies that support Latino families and communities.

San Fernando, CA – City of San Fernando Vice Mayor Antonio Lopez and Councilmember Robert Gonzales joined the National Association of Latino Elected and Appointed Officials (NALEO) Educational Fund and the Latino Policy and Politics Initiative (LPPI) at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), for the first *NALEO National Education Leadership and Public Policy Academy* held August 3-5, 2018.

The three-day intensive, by invitation only, convening brought Vice Mayor Lopez and Councilmember Gonzales together with a cohort of 60 Latino state legislators, county and municipal officials, higher education trustees, and school board members to learn about effective public policies that support Latino families and communities, including strategies for supporting the success of Latino boys and men.
