CITY OF SAN FERNANDO DECLARES JUNE AS PRIDE MONTH AND HOSTS FLAG RAISING EVENT TO MARK THE OCCASION

SAN FERNANDO, CA – Earlier this week, the San Fernando City Council adopted a Resolution declaring June as "Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer Pride Month (LGBTQ+) in the City of San Fernando and call[ed] upon all residents to eliminate prejudice everywhere it exists, and to celebrate the great diversity of our city."

To commemorate this historic Resolution, the City will be hosting a Pride Flag Raising Ceremony on the steps of San Fernando City Hall on Friday, June 25, 2021, at 10 a.m. Mayor Sylvia Ballin will join other City Councilmembers, local dignitaries, and LGBTQ+ representatives to mark this momentous occasion and raise the Pride Flag for the first time at City Hall.

Raising the LGBTQ+ Pride Flag at City Hall is meant to increase awareness, acceptance, and inclusion of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer individuals. The public is invited to attend the ceremony and show their support.
