

2023 Counselor In Training (C.I.T.) Application

Current $9^{th} - 11^{th}$ grade students will be provided with the opportunity to participate in a career/volunteer development program consisting of leadership and service activities. They will be given essential guidance and a support system that is designed to help youth examine the values inherent in human service, as either a career or a volunteer pursuit.

Job Description

Counselors in Training (CITs) assist Counselors and Staff. Counselors in Training help with supervising campers in their group during recreation times, meal times, and assist with camp preparation, clean-up, camper check-in, serve as a positive role model for young children, and help to create a supportive camp community. CITs will be taught leadership skills, public speaking skills, enhance their teamwork skills, learn how to lead a group of younger children safely, and learn skills to teach to others.

Responsibilities

- Assist in providing a quality summer camp program by supporting in daily activities, general care, supervision of campers and fostering a safe and fun environment.
- Campers Come First! Aid children in their learning by providing a good example. Act as a positive role model.
- Associate with campers NOT other counselors in training.
- Be punctual and an active part of all camp activities. Communicate with Counselor when tardy or absent.
- · Attend orientation and trainings.
- Abide by all rules, policies and procedures.
- Treat all campers equally with dignity and respect. There should be no favorites.
- Interact cooperatively with Director, Staff, Counselors, peers, and campers.
- Display a positive "can do" attitude and genuine enthusiasm with integrity and adaptability.

Specific Duties

- Aid counselors by helping to get equipment and supplies ready for activities
- Help to secure supplies and equipment after activities
- Support children in keeping track of their possessions
- Help Staff and Counselors get children to activities and lunch areas
- Contribute ideas to improve the program
- Report any unsafe actions by campers or other CITs to your appointed Counselor
- Assist in cleaning and disposing of trash
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance

- I further certify that said participant is of good health, has no physical or other impairment which would endanger him/her in participating in such an activity program and fully understands the risk involved in such a program.

In the event of accident, injury or illness of the named participant, consent is hereby given to any x-ray examination, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis or treatment and hospital care which is deemed advisable by and is to be rendered under the general or special supervision of any physician and surgeon licensed under the provisions of the Medicine Practice Act on the Medical Staff. I also give my permission for any necessary medical treatment. I realize that any medical bills will be my responsibility. In the event of injury to my child, legal ward and/or myself, I do hereby assume responsibility therefore, and hereby waive any and all claims for damages or loss against the City of San Fernando, the San Fernando Recreation and Community Services Department employees, and activity leaders.
