### **CITY OF SAN FERNANDO AND LOS ANGELES COUNTY SUPERVISOR LINDSEY P. HORVATH ANNOUNCE OVER \$230,000 IN FUNDING TO SUPPORT SAN FERNANDO TOGETHER**

**SAN FERNANDO, CA** – On Friday, September 19, 2025, the San Fernando City Council and County Supervisor Lindsey Horvath hosted a press event celebrating the *San Fernando Together* initiative. At the event, the City and County announced more than \$230,000 in financial support for expanded programming, highlighting the work of program partners Ignite the Light of Hope Foundation and Home Again LA.

San Fernando Together was launched on July 21, 2025, offering one-time financial assistance to community members impacted by immigration-related activities, as well as food distribution, grocery delivery, mental health services, case management referrals, legal aid, and business support.

The City Council approved up to \$15,000 in funding for Home Again LA and \$10,000 in funding for Ignite the Light of Hope Foundation to begin their programming in July 2025. In August 2025, the City Council also approved a Business License Fee Amnesty Program waiving approximately \$138,000 fines/fees to support 115 local businesses in the City.

The County Supervisor awarded \$50,000 to Ignite the Light of Hope Foundation and \$25,000 to Home Again LA. This contribution will expand the City's existing efforts and strengthen community support through the *San Fernando Together* initiative.

**SAN FERNANDO, CA** – El viernes 19 de septiembre de 2025, el Concejo Municipal de San Fernando y la Supervisora del Condado Lindsey Horvath realizaron una rueda de prensa para celebrar la iniciativa San Fernando Together. Para ampliar aún más la programación, la Ciudad y el Condado anunciaron más de \$230,000 en apoyo financiero proporcionado a través de ambas entidades y celebraron el trabajo de los socios del programa: Ignite the Light of Hope Foundation y Home Again LA.

San Fernando Together se lanzó el 21 de julio de 2025, ofreciendo asistencia financiera única a los miembros de la comunidad afectados por actividades relacionadas con la inmigración, así como distribución de alimentos, entrega de comestibles, servicios de salud mental, referencias para gestión de casos, asistencia legal y apoyo a negocios.

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El Concejo Municipal aprobó hasta \$15,000 en fondos para Home Again LA y \$10,000 para Ignite the Light of Hope Foundation para iniciar su programación en julio de 2025. En agosto de 2025, el Concejo Municipal también aprobó un Programa de Amnistía de Tarifas de Licencias Comerciales, condonando aproximadamente \$138,000 en multas y tarifas para apoyar a 115 negocios locales en la Ciudad.

La Supervisora del Condado otorgó \$50,000 a Ignite the Light of Hope Foundation y \$25,000 a Home Again LA. Esta contribución ampliará los esfuerzos existentes de la Ciudad y fortalecerá el apoyo comunitario a través de la iniciativa San Fernando Together.
